- I. Is the site compatible with instructional requirements?
 - A. Are the required resources and tools available in the learning site or can it accommodate them if provided?
 - B. Technology is often used to learn the subject, to communicate about it or to track achievement. Is it possible to incorporate it?
- II. Are the training and work environments compatible?
 - A. Can the training environment simulate factors that are critical to the target performance?
 - B. Can changes be made?
- III. Is the site adaptable per the requirements of delivery approaches?
 - A. Can the training be delivered face-to-face, on the job or online?
- IV. Are there other constraints that affect the course design and delivery?
 - A. Has the client demanded that the training be delivered via a specific technology, offered just in time, not in a classroom setting, individualized, or set within a virtual community with real-time interactions?
